Attention ALL SPEARFISHERS

Here are some specific tips on how to behave around other user groups:

- 1. Follow 'first in first served' principle. Respect the right of swimmers, anglers, other users or spearfishers who are already in the area
- 2. Keep well clear of swimmers or surfers regardless
- 3. Always unload your gun and cover your spearhead if passing through other water users.
- 4. Carry your gun/spear in a bag or wrapping, & avoid beaches, walkways, promenades etc.
- 5. Enter the water away from other water users, swimmers or snorkelers. Avoid going close to others whilst in the water & never allow your gun/spear to point at anyone. Look around constantly to avoid being to close.
- 6. Be aware of the General Public and do not engage in actions which may endanger them.
- 7. Respect the feelings of others who may be frightened or intimidated by your appearance & the gun/spear you may be carrying.
- 8. Avoid, where possible, 'in your face' behaviour when spearfishing or when entering or leaving the water. **WALK AWAY FROM CONFLICT.**
